Sub: Issue of NOC for opening of new nursing institutions in the State.

In order to facilitate smooth implementation of Nursing Education in the State, after careful consideration the Government in Health & FW Department have taken the following decisions:

- a. No more private ANM institutions are to be opened in the State for 2017-18.
- b. As per O.M. No.F.No.-18-SNRC/2017-INC dated 20.04.2017 of the INC, Nursing schools may have to work out a plan to discontinue the GNM course as GNM qualification may be phased out in near future.
- c. Basic B.Sc. Nursing and Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing may be encouraged in the State following the guidelines of INC.
- d. Additional Clinical Institutions needs to be explored to decongest the overload hospitals.
- e. The private institutions who are presently attached to DHHs, Capital Hospital, RGH, Medical College Hospitals are to be advised to start their own hospital or do alternate arrangements without violating the INC guidelines for clinical/ practical training.
- f. The overloaded hospitals / facilities can arrange 2 shifts of clinical practice for students to ease the load.
- g. The hospitals are required to allow the genuine students admitted through e-counselling for practical / clinical training.
